In march of 2012 was signed an agreement between CNPq, CISB and SAAB AB and a work plan in order to promote Science and Technological Activities considering the priority areas of the Science Without Borders Program .

The work plan provided scholarships to doctorate sandwich and post-doctoral in the following areas:

- Materials and Production;
- Electronic;
- Technology of Information and Communication; and
- Mechanical Engineering Systems.

Notes: CISB / SAAB has the commitment to pay a extra monthly amount scholarship to the researcher on the same value paid by CNPq. It's possible a monthly additional in the scholarship value (€ 400,00) for high-cost cities.

Science Without Borders Program



The main goal of the program is to promote the consolidation and expansion of science, technology and innovation in Brazil by means of international exchange and mobility.

The strategy envisioned aims to:

- a) increase the presence of students, scientists and industry personnel from Brazil in international institutions of excellence;
- b) encourage young talents and highly qualified researchers from abroad to work with local investigators in joint projects;
- c) induce the internationalization of universities and research centers in Brazil by encouraging the establishment of international partnerships.

Total approved: 9 projects, (7 post-doctoral (PDE) and 2 for doctoral sandwich (SWE)).

Total demand: 25 projects (21 post-doctoral (PDE) and 4 for doctoral sandwich (SWE)).

Total approved: 10 projects, (7 post-doctoral (PDE) and 3 for doctoral sandwich (SWE)).

Goal: This call aimed to select candidates who want to develop part of their thesis or postdoctoral project, within the priority areas of the Program Science Without Borders and in the research areas of interest SAAB AB.

Support items: Scholarships for short term doctoral (sandwich) and post-doctoral scholarships (SWE and PDE).

Total demand: 108 projects (70 post-doctoral (PDE) and 38 for doctoral sandwich (SWE) – Most of this project were disqualified for not belong to the priority areas).

Total approved: 06 projects, (2 post-doctoral (PDE) and 4 for doctoral sandwich (SWE)).

Important issues about the selection of the projects in CNPq/CISB/SAAB public calls.



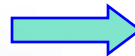
The selection of proposals submitted to the CNPq/CISB/SAAB public call must following five steps:

- 1# Step: Pre-selection by the CNPq technical team;
- 2# Step: Analysis by external consultants (Ad hoc consultants);
- 3# Step: Analysis and classification by a Specialist Committee;
- 4# Step: Interview of the selected candidates by CISB/SAAB;
- 5# Step: Final decision by the CNPq Executive Board.

The goal of the CISB/SAAB interview is to proceed an evaluation about the language skills of the candidates and the project relevance to SAAB. So, normally between the 3# and 4# Steps some projects are disqualified.

Goal: This call aimed to select candidates within the priority areas of the Program Science Without Borders and in the research areas of interest SAAB AB.

Support items: Scholarships for short term doctoral (sandwich) and post-doctoral scholarships (SWE and PDE).

Expected to be launched in December 1th, 2014, offering 5 scholarships for short term doctoral (sandwich) and 10 postdoctoral scholarships (SWE and PDE).
