

#### A. INTRODUCTION

The ITA-SU is a framework program to support collaborative research projects between ITA and Swedish Universities mainly in the field of aeronautics and defence. The goal of ITA-SU is to generate technological knowledge and capacitate human resources to develop innovative solutions for aeronautics and defence stakeholders.

This proposal is grounded in the framework agreement for defence cooperation between Brazil and Sweden, signed on April 3rd, 2014, by the Defence Minister of Sweden, Karin Engităm, and the Defence Minister of Brazil, Celsa Amgrim. This agreement reaffirms the intentions of collaboration indicated in the 2009 Plan of Action of the Sweden-Brazil Strategic Partnership. It is also related with the Additional Protocol on Innovative High Technological Industrial Cooperation, signed in 2009 between the two countries, which affirms a shared interest to strengthen high technological cooperation.
